

## DRESS RULES

Clean, smart dress shall be worn on the course and in the clubhouse as appropriate. Shirts or golf tops must be tucked into waistband.

In the lounge bar, golf clothing, which is wet, dirty or otherwise showing signs of recent use on the course must not be worn.

The chart below shows dress that is permitted (indicated by 'Yes') and dress, that is not permitted (indicated by 'No'). These rules do not apply to children under the age of 10.

	<b>Clubhouse</b>	No	Yes
Shorts: Typically will have 2 side pockets and up to 2 rear pockets, belt hoops and some will have turn ups. Ladies only may wear ¾ length trousers. <b>Not permitted are:</b> multi-coloured beach shorts, combat shorts (multiple pockets), elasticated waistbands or any type that uses a string to tie at the waist.	<b>Course</b>	Yes	Yes
	<b>Clubhouse: Up to 7.30 p.m.</b>	Yes	Yes
	<b>After 7.30 p.m.</b>	No	No
Socks must be worn at all times on the course. Calf length socks must be white. Knee length or trainer socks may be any colour. In the Clubhouse, trainer socks are not permitted for gentlemen.		Yes	Yes

Changing clothes or shoes should not take place in the car park.

Persons not complying with these rules will be asked to leave the course and/or clubhouse as appropriate.

These rules also apply to caddies and visitors accompanying golfers.
